Terms of Use for Data and Agreement

These Terms of Use for Data (hereinafter, these Terms) set forth the terms and conditions of use for experimental data, input data for numuercial simulation and related data (hereinafter, the Data) provided by NIPPON KAIJI KYOKAI (hereinafter, ClassNK). Article 1. Terms of use of the Data

Article 3. Disclaimer

- 1. ClassNK makes no warranty that the Data will be free from defects regarding the accuracy or completeness of the Data.
- 2. Neither ClassNK nor any of its officers or employees shall be liable for any damages, etc. incurred by the Users or a third party arising out of or in connection with the use of or inablity to use the Data.
- 3. Either ClassNK or any of its officers or employees shall not be obliged to maintain the Data or deal with any defects.

Article 4. Amendments

ClassNK reserves the right to amend or change these Terms from time to time. In such case, the terms and conditions for the Users shall be governed by the amended Terms.

Article 5. Suspension or termination of the use of the Data by ClassNK

1. If any of the following events set forth below occur to the User, ClassNK may immediately suspend or

terminate the use of the Data by the Users without any notice or demand and any compensation:

- (1) If the User breaches these Terms;
- (2) If a petition is filed to the User for the commencement of bankruptcy proceedings, civil rehabilitation proceedings, corporate reorganization proceedings, special liquidation, or other similar insolvency proceedings, or the assets of the User become subject to provisional seizure, provisional disposition, or compulsory execution by a third party;
- (3) If the User is discovered to have a relationship with Anti-Social Forces; or
- (4) If it is judged to be inappropriate by ClassNK that the User continues to use the Data.

Article 7. Geverning law

These Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Japan.

Article 8. Dispute Resolution

- 1. Any and all disputes arising out of or in connection with these Terms or the use of the Data shall be submitted by each party to the Tokyo Maritime Arbitration Commision of the Japan Shipping Exchange, Inc. while designating Tokyo as the seat and place of arbitration. The award given by an arbitrator(s) shall be final and binding upon both parties.
- 2. The selection of an arbitrator(s), arbitration procedure and any other matters related to arbitrations shall be addressed pursuant to the Rules of Arbitration of the Tokyo Maritime Arbitration Commission of the Japan Shipping Exchange, Inc.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraphs, the Tokyo District Court shall have exclusive jurisdiction in the first instance over any and all disputes arising out of or in connection with these Terms or the use of the Data between ClassNK and Users whose head office is located in Japan.

Article 9. Consultations

Any matter not stipulated in these Terms shall be resolved throught good faith consultation between ClassNK and the Users.
