AMENDMENT TO “AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR THE SURVEY AND CONSTRUCTION OF STEEL SHIPS (Rule No. 45 dated 16th December 2005)”

In the “AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR THE SURVEY AND CONSTRUCTION OF STEEL SHIPS (Rule No. 45 dated 16th December 2005)”, the EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION for Amendment 3-3 has been amended as follows:

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION (Amendment 3-3)

1. The effective date of the amendments is 1 January 2007.
2. Notwithstanding the amendments to the Rules, the current requirements may apply to ships the keels of which were laid or which were at *a similar stage of construction* before the effective date.  
(Note) The term “*a similar stage of construction*” means the stage at which the construction identifiable with a specific ship begins and the assembly of that ship has commenced comprising at least 50 *tonnes* or 1% of the estimated mass of all structural material, whichever is the less.
