Rule No.30 30th June 2011 AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR RADIO INSTALLATIONS

"Rules for radio installations" has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 1 GENERAL

1.1 General

1.1.1 Application

Sub-paragraph -3 has been added as follows.

- 1 Rules for Radio Installations (hereinafter referred to as "the Rules") apply to the radio installations of ships classed or to be classed with NIPPON KAIJI KYOKAI (hereinafter referred to as "the Society") under **Chapter 2 of the Regulations for the Classification and Registry of Ships** and intended to be registered under **Chapter 3** of the same Regulations.
- 2 To radio installations fitted in passenger ships, the Society may apply additional requirements as specified in Chapter IV of the Annex to the Convention.
- 3 In addition to the relevant requirements in Part P of the Rules for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships, radio installations in mobile offshore drilling units are to comply with the requirements in Chapter 11 of IMO Resolution A.1023(26) "The Code for the Construction and Equipment of Mobile Offshore Drilling Units" (MODU Code).

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

- 1. The effective date of the amendments is 1 January 2012.
- 2. Notwithstanding the amendments to the Rules, the current requirements may apply to units the keels of which were laid or which were at *a similar stage of construction* before the effective date.
 - (Note) The term "a similar stage of construction" means the stage at which the construction identifiable with a specific unit begins and the assembly of that unit has commenced comprising at least 50 tonnes or 1% of the estimated mass of all structural material, whichever is the less.
