Notice No.12 26th February 2014 AMENDMENT TO THE GUIDANCE FOR NAVIGATION BRIDGE SYSTEMS

"Guidance for navigation bridge systems" has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 3 BRIDGE LAYOUTS AND BRIDGE WORKING ENVIRONMENTS

3.2 Bridge Working Environments

Paragraph 3.2.3 has been amended as follows.

3.2.3 Noise

Permissible noise levels use <u>IMO Resolution A. 468(12)</u>Annex B2.3.1-1.(11) "PROCEDURES FOR ON BOARD NOISE MEASUREMENTS", Part B of the Guidance for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships as a standard.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

- **1.** The effective date of the amendments is 1 July 2014.
- 2. Notwithstanding the amendments to the Guidance, the current requirements may apply to ships other than ships that fall under the following:
 - (1) for which the building contract is placed on or after 1 July 2014; or
 - (2) in the absence of a building contract, the keels of which are laid or which are at *a similar stage of construction* on or after 1 January 2015; or
 - (Note) The term "a similar stage of construction" means the stage at which the construction identifiable with a specific ship begins and the assembly of that ship has commenced comprising at least 50 tonnes or 1% of the estimated mass of all structural material, whichever is the less.
 - (3) the delivery of which is on or after 1 July 2018
