AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUE OF STATUTORY CERTIFICATES

“Regulations for the issue of statutory certificates” has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 2 CERTIFICATES AND THEIR VALIDITY

2.1 Statutory Certificates

Paragraph 2.1.1 has been amended as follows.

2.1.1 Definitions

In these Regulations, “statutory certificates” mean the following certificates including those certificates of compliance required under the Conventions, etc. to be kept on board the ships:

(20) Polar Ship Certificate

2.2 Validity of Statutory Certificates

2.2.1 Validity

Sub-paragraph -1 has been amended as follows.

1 The validity of statutory certificates ~~are~~ is to be as follows according to the kind of statutory certificate, and unless otherwise provided for by the flag state of the ship.

((1) to (17) are omitted.)

(18) Polar Ship Certificate

(a) 5 years for cargo ships

(b) 1 year for passenger ships
