“Rules for marine pollution prevention systems” has been partly amended as follows:

Part 2 SURVEYS

Chapter 1 GENERAL

1.1 General

1.1.2 Kinds of Surveys

Sub-paragraph -1(4) has been added as follows.

1 Construction and equipment for the prevention of pollution from ships registered or intended to be registered are to subject to the following surveys:

- (1) Registration Surveys
- (2) Periodical Surveys
- (3) Occasional Surveys
- (4) Unscheduled Surveys

1.1.3 Intervals of Surveys*

Sub-paragraph -6 has been added as follows.

6 Unscheduled Surveys

The classed ships may be subject to Unscheduled Surveys when the confirmation of the status of the ship by survey is deemed necessary in cases where the Society suspects the ship of not being in continued compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Society, and of not being properly maintained and operated by the ship owner. At Unscheduled Surveys, investigations, examinations or tests are to be made to the satisfaction of the Surveyor with respect to the matters concerned.
