Rule No.40 15 February 2018 AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR CENTRALIZED CARGO MONITORING AND CONTROL SYSTEMS

"Rules for centralized cargo monitoring and control systems" has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 2 SURVEYS

2.1 General

2.1.1 Kinds of Surveys

Sub-paragraph (2) has been amended as follows.

Centralized cargo monitoring and control systems registered or intended to be registered are to be subjected to the following surveys:

- (1) Surveys for the registration of centralized cargo monitoring and control systems (hereinafter referred to as "Registration Surveys")
- (2) Surveys for maintaining the registration of centralized cargo monitoring and control systems (hereinafter referred to as "Registration Maintenance Surveys"), which are:
 - (a) Special Surveys
 - (b) Annual Surveys
 - (c) Occasional Surveys
 - (d) Unscheduled Surveys

2.1.2 Survey Intervals

Sub-paragraph (2) has been amended as follows.

- (2) Registration Maintenance Surveys are to be carried out at those times as prescribed in (a) to (e)(d) below.
 - ((a) to (c) are omitted.)
 - (d) The classed ships may be subject to Unscheduled Surveys when the confirmation of the status of systems by survey is deemed necessary in cases where the Society suspects systems of not being in continued compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Society, and of not being properly maintained and operated by the ship owner.

2.3 Registration Maintenance Surveys

Paragraph 2.3.4 has been added as follows.

2.3.4 Unscheduled Surveys

At Unscheduled Surveys, investigations, examinations or tests are to be made to the satisfaction of the Surveyor with respect to the matters concerned.
