Rule No.61 30 June 2020 AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR CENTRALIZED CARGO MONITORING AND CONTROL SYSTEMS

"Rules for centralized cargo monitoring and control systems" has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 2 SURVEYS

2.1 General

2.1.2 Survey Intervals

Sub-paragraph (2) has been amended as follows.

- (2) Registration Maintenance Surveys are to be carried out at those times as prescribed in (a) to (d) below.
 - ((a) to (c) are omitted.)
 - (d) The classed ships may be subject to Unscheduled Surveys when the confirmation of the status of systems by survey is deemed necessary in cases where the Society suspects systems of not being in continued compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Society, and of not being properly maintained and operated by the ship owner considers the systems to be subject to 1.4-3 of the CONDITIONS OF SERVICE FOR CLASSIFICATION OF SHIPS AND REGISTRATION OF INSTALLATIONS.
