Rules No.60 30 June 2020 AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR HULL MONITORING SYSTEMS

"Rules for hull monitoring systems" has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 2 SURVEY

2.1 General

2.1.2 Time and Intervals of Surveys

Sub-paragraph -2(3) has been amended as follows.

- 2 Registration Maintenance Surveys are to be carried out at the following intervals:
- (1) Annual Surveys are to be carried out at those times stipulated in 1.1.3-1(1), Part B of the Rules for Survey and Construction of Steel Ships
- (2) Notwithstanding (1) above, Occasional Surveys are to be carried out independently of Annual Surveys in cases where:
 - To implement the survey, in lieu of the traditional ordinary surveys where a surveyor is in attendance, the Society may approve the survey methods which it considers to be able to obtain information equivalent to that obtained through traditional ordinary surveys.
 - (a) Any main parts of systems have been damaged, repaired or renewed.
 - (b) Any systems are modified or altered.
 - (c) It is considered necessary by the Society.
- (3) The classed ships may be subject to Unscheduled Surveys when the confirmation of the status of systems by survey is deemed necessary in cases where the Society suspects systems of not being in continued compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Society, and of not being properly maintained and operated by the ship owner considers the systems to be subject to 1.4-3 of the CONDITIONS OF SERVICE FOR CLASSIFICATION OF SHIPS AND REGISTRATION OF INSTALLATIONS.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

1. The effective date of the amendments is 30 June 2020.
