Notice No.31 30 June 2022 AMENDMENT TO THE GUIDANCE FOR THE SURVEY AND CONSTRUCTION OF STEEL SHIPS

"Guidance for the survey and construction of steel ships" has been partly amended as follows:

Part C HULL CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPMENT

C23 BULWARKS, GUARDRAILS, FREEING ARRANGEMENTS, CARGO PORTS AND OTHER SIMILAR OPENINGS, SIDE SCUTTLES, RECTANGULAR WINDOWS, VENTILATORS AND GANGWAYS

C23.7 Gangways

C23.7.1 General

Sub-paragraph -3 has been amended as follows.

- 3 Precautions regarding arrangements specified in -1 above
- (1) Where wire ropes are fitted, turnbuckles are to be provided to ensure their tautness.
- (<u>+2</u>) Wire ropes may only be acceptable in lieu of guard rails in special circumstances and then only in limited lengths.
- (<u>≥3</u>) Lengths of chain may only be acceptable in lieu of guard rails where fitted in between two fixed stanchions.
- (34) Where stanchions are fitted, every third stanchion is to be supported by a bracket or stay.
- (45) Removable or hinged stanchions shall be capable of being locked in the upright position.
- (56) A means of passage over obstructions, if any, such as pipes or other fittings of a permanent nature, should be provided.
- (67) Generally, the width of the gangway and deck-level walkway should not exceed 1.5m.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

1. The effective date of the amendments is 1 July 2022.
