Outline of the amendment

Up until now, IACS has enacted and amended a large number of unified interpretations (hereinafter referred to as UIs) that are related to international conventions and codes. According to application of these international conventions and codes, all of the requirements stipulated with regard to UIs have been applied through Rules, Instructions, etc. However, not all of these UIs were previously specified in the Rules of the Society.

Then, in October 2006, IACS adopted Procedural Requirements No.31 (hereinafter referred to PR No.31) which requires that all UIs are to be specified in the Rules of classification societies.

In order to comply with PR No.31, the Society has decided to specify the requirements of any UIs that were not previously included in the Rules.

Therefore, this amendment was designed to incorporate the UIs related to ICLL that were not previously specified in the Rules. In addition, some parts related to this matter were amended in line with the requirements stipulated in Part C of the Rules for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships.

Outline of Amendment
