Reason for Amendment

The requirements regarding offshore mooring chains given in the ClassNK Rules are based on IACS Unified Requirements W22. However, requests have been received from industry regarding the creation of requirements dealing specifically with higher strength offshore mooring chains.

Currently, a revision of United Requirement W22 regarding such chains in being deliberated on by IACS. This amendment has been introduced in order to incorporate the results of those deliberations into the Rules.

Outline of Amendment

This amendment has specified requirements related to Grade R4S offshore chains and Grade R5 offshore chains, and has added standard values for such chains into these requirements.
