

# **The Permeability of Store Space**

## **Amended Guidance**

Guidance for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships Part V

## **Reason for Amendment**

It is stipulated in the International Convention on Load Lines (ILLC) that the assumed permeability of compartments in the damage stability calculation is to be 0.95. However, there is no stipulation for permeability of store spaces in this convention.

Therefore, in order to clarify that the assumed permeability of such store spaces in the requirement given in the ILLC is to be 0.95, IACS adopted Unified Interpretation LL75 in September 2008.

Accordingly, relevant requirements have been amended in accordance with IACS Unified Interpretation LL75.

## **Outline of Amendment**

This draft amendment has specified that the assumed permeability of store spaces in the damage stability calculation given in the ILLC is to be 0.95.
