Rules for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships Part R

Reason for Amendment

At the 88th Session of the IMO Maritime Safety Committee (MSC88), SOLAS regulation II-2/7 was amended to require that fixed fire detection and alarm systems be installed in enclosed spaces containing incinerators for the purpose of quickly detecting any fire caused by said incinerators. These amendments were adopted as Resolution MSC.308(88).

Therefore, relevant requirements have been amended in accordance with MSC.308(88).

Outline of Amendment

To add the requirement that fixed fire detection and alarm systems are to be installed in enclosed spaces containing incinerators.
