Reason for Amendment

A revision of the "Survey Guidelines Under the Harmonized System of Survey and Certification (HSSC)" (hereinafter referred to as the "HSSC guidelines") was adopted by the IMO Assembly as Resolution A.1186(33) at its 33rd Session, taking into account relevant IMO instruments and amendments thereto entering into force before or on 31 December 2023. The revision included the addition of requirements related to the treatment of remote survey schemes for statutory surveys.

Although the treatment of remote surveys with respect to class surveys in the NK Rules had been clarified in December 2022, the treatment of remote surveys with respect to installation surveys equivalent to statutory surveys was still being discussed by the IMO, and thus could not be clarified until the IMO had completed its discussions.

Accordingly, relevant requirements are clarified based upon Resolution A.1186(33).

Outline of Amendment

The methods for which such surveys are to be deemed appropriate by Administrations in accordance with the HSSC guidelines are added in the conditions under which remote surveys for installation surveys equivalent to statutory surveys.

Effective Date and Application

This amendment applies to surveys for which the application is submitted to the Society on or after 1 January 2025.

An asterisk (*) after the title of a requirement indicates that there is also relevant information in the corresponding Guidance.
